



Community Natural Area Management Contract

Provisions of the Contract:

- ❑ The community group and TCC Environmental Management Services (EMS) will facilitate the development, coordination, and implementation of identified and agreed projects
- ❑ Projects will be identified either in an implementation plan for the natural area/ reserve or as agreed between the group/ volunteers and Council
- ❑ The following types of voluntary work may be carried out:
 - ◆ seed collection and plant propagation
 - ◆ native tube stock planting's, mulching & watering
 - ◆ identify and tag regenerating native vegetation
 - ◆ map and control weeds (physical/ chemical consistent with relevant WH&S procedures and MSDS for chemical if used)
 - ◆ fauna survey & advice on management
 - ◆ grass control for wildfire management (Especially Nelly Bay Habitat)
 - ◆ provision of local advice to Council on management of the area
 - ◆ Assisting in minor restoration works on the Horseshoe Bay Schoolhouse.
- ❑ Community group to provide lists of members conducting work and notify EMS staff prior to work commencing or via an agreed work plan (including Conservation Volunteers Australia/ Green Corp groups).
- ❑ EMS will notify the community of any work to be conducted in the natural areas
- ❑ Work is to be consistent with the volunteer work agreements, site management plans, TCC Policies and the community's capacities
- ❑ Where possible, Council will provide agreed resources to enable the community to carry out effective habitat restoration and rehabilitation
