### **Ross River NHT – “Strategic Rehabilitation of Ross River: An Urban Catchment March 2000 – 2002**

During this period 16, 312 seedlings and an extra 10,000 seedlings were propagated.

There were:

- 170 community members involved throughout the whole project

- 17 State Government Employee
- 42 other organisations including developers and local industry

12 Community Revegetation Groups were developed during this period. 6 of the groups are still held monthly meeting → continued their involvement in the Habitat Project.
