### COMMUNITY GREENING EVENT

## You are invited to a community tree planting in your neighbourhood

Townsville City Council is hosting a community tree planting in your local area. This planting will complement the 2005 National Tree Day community planting by Greening Townsville and the Community Environment Fund where more than 100 people planted 1,000 local native shrubs and trees. A third community planting will be held in this area in March 2006, helping establish this area as a green corridor.

# Dalrymple Road Community Revegetation and Amenity Planting

- Where: Dalrymple Road, Currajong. Site is located between Bayswater Road and Woolock Street (on left hand side, travelling outbound). Parking is on Dalrymple Service Road.
- **When:** Sunday, 27 November 2005
- **» Time:** 8:00–10:00am
- What to bring: Hat, gloves, sturdy closed footwear, sunscreen and drinking water.
- » Enjoy a free BBQ and drinks after the planting and take home a free local native plant complete with growing instructions.

#### **Community Environment Fund**

The Community Environment Fund is a three-year project funded by a \$500,000 community grant from Powerlink Queensland and \$500,000 from project partners the Townsville City Council and Thuringowa City Council.

The Fund aims to form partnerships and undertake projects that enhance the environmental properties of the Townsville and Thuringowa region, and to minimise the visual impact on the community of the electricity infrastructure owned, operated and maintained by Powerlink Queensland.
