To celebrate National Tree Day, Townsville City Council, in conjunction with Mundy Creekwatch and Conservation Volunteers Australia, is hosting a community tree planting along Mundy Creek. The planting will be a combination of local native trees and shrubs which will enhance the habitat values of the Mundy Creek riparian zone. A second planting will also be held at the same time at Soroptimist Park, Rowes Bay supported by Soroptimist International.
